Salt Lake City has drafted an anti-displacement and mitigation plan, called Thriving in Place, and is notifying your organization to solicit comments on the proposal.

Request Description:

After undertaking a community-driven engagement process to develop a plan of action, Salt Lake City has prepared a draft anti-displacement and mitigation plan for public review and comment. The current draft of Thriving in Place is available for public review and comment at <https://www.thrivinginplaceslc.org/>.

Links to the project website have been attached to facilitate your review.

Request for Input from Your Recognized Organization

As part of this process, the city is required to solicit comments from Recognized Organizations. The purpose of the Recognized Organization review is to inform the community of the project and solicit comments/concerns they have with the project. The Recognized Organization may also take a vote to determine whether there is support for the project, but this is not required.

Per City Code 2.60.050 - The recognized community organization chair(s) have **forty-five (45) days** to provide comments, from the date the notice was sent. A public hearing will not be held, nor will a final decision be made about the project within the forty-five (45) day notice period. This notice period ends on the following day:

June 26, 2023

Please contact Ruedigar Matthes if your organization would like a City representative to attend and present the proposal at a meeting within this 45-day period. Please indicate the day and time of your meeting and staff will coordinate with the applicant to attend your meeting. Staff will be available at the meeting to answer any questions related to the proposed plan.

Comment Guidance

Public comments will be received up to the date of the Planning Commission public hearing. However, Recognized Community organization's comments should be submitted within 45 days (before June 26, 2023) of receiving this notice in order for those comments to be included in the staff report.

As a Recognized Organization, we ask that you address the following questions in your comments:

- What issues were raised at the meeting and whether any suggestions were made to address the issues.
- The number of persons that attended the meeting (not including City Staff).
- Whether a vote was taken on the matter and if so, what the vote tally was.
