Project Overview

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will improve I-80 between 1300 East and 2300 East and I-215 between 3300 South and 4500 South. The pavement will be replaced with new concrete throughout, and a new lane will be added to eastbound I-80 between 1300 East and 2300 East.

Additional improvements will include:

- Demolition and reconstruction of the 1300 East and 1700 East bridges over I-80
- Demolition and reconstruction of the I-80 bridge over 2000 East
- Widening of the I-80 bridge over 2300 East to accommodate the new eastbound lane
- Improvements to existing bike and pedestrian crossings at I-80

This project is being done to replace aging infrastructure, reduce congestion and enhance safety.

Construction is scheduled to begin as early as May 2021 and continue through 2022.

All lanes on I-80 and I-215 are anticipated to remain open Monday through Friday during commute hours, with lane closures primarily overnight and on the weekends.
